

"THE BEAUTY OF THE BODY of CHRIST"



[2/4] This newsletter is uncommonly late but for good reason. I returned home two days ago from a 7 day, 8 speaking engagements' ministry trip to VA. These meetings included 4 whole-family services & 4 Christian school chapels. It was a large Assembly of God church outside of Washington, D.C. [www.wolag.org], where I have ministered before. What I love about this church is its diversity re: the numerous & various nationalities which attend there. Painted on one of the walls of the sanctuary is the Scripture verse, "From every tribe, tongue, language, & nation" & that is exactly what the church is comprised of. White Caucasians are in the minority! At the church's Christian school, where approximately 100 kindergarteners through 8th graders attend-only about 5 were white! I saw Blacks, Hispanics, Asians, Asian-Indians, Russians, etc. It was such a beautiful sight to behold. I felt as if it were a preview of Heaven. To top things off, speaking of the diversity of the Body of Christ, I preached this morning here in DE at a mostly Chinese-comprised church! Again, it was beautiful to behold. I consider this one of the many privileges of what our Lord has called me to-to behold the manifold diversity of His people.

"MUTUAL DNA INSERTION"

While driving down to VA the week before, I saw in my mind's eye a cell under a scientist's microscope, with the scientist puncturing the cell with a very fine needle to insert DNA into the cell. I'm sure many of you have seen such pictures. This scene I envisioned was actually my prayer for the week. I wanted to be used by our Lord to insert something into this church body that they didn't have. I wanted to add something to their "DNA", so to speak, that would further their growth & progress in the Lord. I wanted to lay some golden bricks of doctrine in their hearts-bricks that would stay with them the rest of their lives-doctrines that would affect their everyday lives as they do mine. The pastor, whom I have known & loved for decades & whom I affectionately call "Buddy" [he's in his mid-80's now] gave me "free reign" to minister "how" I feel "inspired" to do it. This included my *Time Machine* & numerous & various object lessons. I "crowded" his platform with them, but like I said, he was so gracious! I love it when I'm trusted by my hosts-when they let me "do what I do how I do it". In 18 years of itinerant ministry this month I've never had one complain about it. They, & their people, have seen that what I do & "how" I do it is "worship" too.

"YOUR INABILITY-YOUR SECURITY"



For the two Sunday morning a.m. services I preached, I gave a detailed Creation/Fall/Redemption message which I entitle "The Gospel Elaborated". After elaborating re: devastation of human depravity via Adam's sin, I eventually get to the resultant inability such sin left us in. I first elaborate on God's wondrous provision to expiate His people's sin, via the *Perfect Substitute's* full satisfaction to the Law's holy demands & justice of God-His "propitiation", i.e., Jesus' removal of the wrath of God, via His death on the cross. I then quote John 3:16. Problem solved, right? All people have to do is believe, right? Not so fast! The same Jesus Who said, "Come to Me..." [Mt.11:28] also said no one had the ability to come to Him unless the Father Who sent Him enabled them [Jn.6:65] & drew them to Him [Jn.6:44]. John wrote that "...the Holy Spirit, Whom the world cannot receive..." [Jn.14:17]-what were we, but part of "the world", before we were regenerated, Beloved? Paul confirms this: "The natural man does not receive the things of the Spirit of God [vis, the gospel ministry: II Cor.3] because they are foolishness to him; neither does he have the ability to do so (!)..." [I Cor.2:14]. Paul said in Rom. 10:9 that in order to be saved one must confess that Jesus is Lord, but I Cor.12:3, Paul also said that no man can do so except by the enabling of the Holy Spirit, Whom as mentioned above sinners [the world] don't have the ability to receive. We're at an impasse here. I then used a drama to illustrate to the audience how at the time of their conversion the Father was enabling them & drawing them to Jesus, without which they would not, & could not, have come. Paul said in Col. 1:13 that at the moment of a Christian's salvation HE was transferring them from the kingdom of darkness into the kingdom of the Son of His love. [I told the audience that NO Christian knows these things at the time of their salvation & that sadly, many won't learn of them until they get to Heaven!

The congregation clapped several times during the message-not for me-God forbid! If that were so I should go into a side room, fall on my face, & weep in deep remorse before the Lord, for stealing the glory from Him! No! They were clapping because they were "getting it"! [You can go to the church's website above & view the message in their archives from the Jan.28 10:30 a.m. service]. One woman came up to me later & said after hearing of God's sovereign intervention & involvement in her conversion, that "it takes the pressure off". A grand-father said his grandson "Samuel" is usually bored in church but that he was paying attention to me. A woman from the church who played "Eve" for me out of my Time Machine later emailed me, "Thank you for teaching the word of God so simple yet so penetrating." A church leader's wife said to me, "We needed you here". [Little did she know how much I needed them!]. God was hearing my prayer en route down-He was inserting some fresh DNA into them!





This DNA insertion was not one-sided by any means! Our Lord inserted so much of this church's DNA in me! Their joy, humility, & freedom in worship was heartmelting & precious. I was born & raised in "The North". I'm the first Yankee to marry on either side of my wife's family! I will be honest-it was an "adjustment" acclimating to her family's "Southern" culture. And this church was filled with "Southerners"! And yet-how very touched & blessed I was by their sincere love of Jesus. The worship leader & his wife were from Georgia & Alabama respectively. I was trying hard not to weep after hearing him minister to the Lord in song so that I could preach afterwards. His wife? She served me as if she were an angel.

"SCHOOLED BY SCHOOL CHILDREN"



I sat amazed as I beheld this church's school children all week. It was so obvious they were bred, fed, & led by godly staff. It made my job for their spiritual emphasis week so much easier. As I've always done with children, I gave them serious, heavy doctrines from the Scriptures-by Jesus' giftings & grace, in a way they could understand & receive. They sang like angels. More than once I didn't want to preach but just listen the whole time to them worship. For one chapel service I did a Time Machine drama & preached but only got through half my message before time ran out. I had no idea of the time-I couldn't see the clock, as I always have the sanctuary dark [both for my drama but also to enhance the kids' attention spans-what they can't see can't distract them! This has never happened to me. It really threw me & I felt as if "nothing was accomplished". My host, the vice-principal of the school, *Cornelius Cross-*an amazingly anointed & gifted man-said it was fine. Despite this kind encouragement, my spirit was grieved. I was hungry for more of a release of God's Spirit next time than what I sensed in this particular chapel. I hit the floor later that afternoon when everyone else had left. I entreated our Father to move more powerfully the next time. We are in a battle here, & every chapel counts. It must. Our Father was faithful to hear the prayer in me that His Spirit inspired!

"HUDDLED & CUDDLED"



At the end of my final chapel there, where I had preached re: the parable of the *Sower*, & how people's destinies are determined [on the human side] by the way they handle the Word of God, Cornelius had the children come forward to give me a hug good-bye. Almost all 100 of them gathered around me-all of them wanting a hug, which I tried to give without falling over [I was that tired-this was service #8 of 8!-the most I've ever done in so short a time in 32 years!]. It was a very tender, bittersweet moment. Oh, how I hated to leave them. For most of the 2+ hours' ride home I listened to children's movie soundtracks' slow songs & let the post-ministry sweetness envelope me. I've often said if the Father should stop sending me to children & teens? Please take me Home, Lord-take me Home.

"AS HE SOWED"



Speaking of the parable of the Sower, one of the most sobering parts of that text is the 2-letter word "as". "As" He sowed...the very teaching of the parable was being fulfilled. As I preached it this a.m. at a Chinese church I frequent about 2X a year-a very precious group to me-I saw it once more fulfilled while it was being delivered. Once again, as so many times in the past with this congregation, our Lord gave us such a sweet time together. The saints there are very receptive, hungry, & respectful to me. Today was no different. Despite the fact that I had preached 8X over the past 7 days, & that I have been suffering with one of the worst sinus-fatigue days of my entire life, I felt our Lord's Spirit once again rise up in me when I needed Him. His surge of conviction, urgency, soberness, & intensity once more came out of this very weak vessel. These (mostly) Chinese saints sat, listened, received, & responded to this key-very key portion of the Word of God. And yet-it is an inevitable part of human nature, that most likely all 4 soils Jesus described were present in the room. Not because they were Chinese, but because they were human. One of the most heart-wrenching aspects of ministry to me is the fact that I know of too many children whom I have worked with through the decades-children who were in kids' church & camp with me, who are now not walking with the Lord. And it's not just a few. As much as I hate to admit it, At times, I can recall more of them not walking with our Lord than those who arechildren with whom I once had "such sweet fellowship in the house of the Lord." There are times in my travels where I will play the kids' movie soundtracks mentioned above & pray for these children by name who are now adults,

entreating our Lord to call them back to Himself. Such is part & parcel of bringing the Word of God to the masses-you constantly encounter all 4 kinds of the soil the parable of the Sower elaborates upon-& 3 of the 4 soils Jesus described didn't "make it"! Fill my seed bag afresh, Lord, as You send me this month to more of Your fields-of all ages!
