#### Dear Friends & Family,

[1/3] This month marks 21 years of our itinerant live-by-faith ministry. Those 21 years have encompassed several thousand miles of travel to numerous & sundry states & involved a plethora of various expressions, denominations, fellowships, etc. of the Body of Christ. I couldn't be more grateful. I have done in these past 21 years what I feel I was made for. I pray it is our Lord's heart that this season & type of ministry for us continues for years to come. And yet, another "love of my life" re: ministry for the past 16 years has come to an end, i.e., "Via Dolorosa". Via was another of many Covid-19 casualties last year. And due to many other factors at Immanuel Church, where it was birthed in 2004, the leadership there decided in the Lord Via's "season" at Immanuel was over. I'm sure it was not an easy decision for them. I would dare say it surely was one of Immanuel's highlights in its 160 year or so history, both for the church family & community outreach. Well, in the light of that, yesterday for Kim & me was an historical day; & a very sad one at that. [Yes, "Via Dolorosa" in Latin does mean "The Way of Sorrows"]. We began to pack up & load the first of many truckloads [4 as of this writing] of Via D props, costumes, etc. for its exodus-16 years' worth-16 years of finding, buying, building, amassing, etc. said props, costumes, & scenery. We spent over 6 hours doing so & this a.m. I'm definitely feeling the pangs of all of the hard labor done yesterday! 

After bringing home the 1st load, we proceeded to "re-bin" everything! We condensed large heavy bins that had dozens of boots, sandals, leather military tunics, breastplates, etc. into smaller ones, without holes, so

as to prevent little fuzzy critters in our backyard shed from ruining them! As I've written many times in the past, **Summer Camps & Via Dolorosa** have been my two biggest "outlets" for who I am in God. Hence, this is huge.





Yet-there are few things more grievous, distressing, & embarrassing in life than when men try to keep something alive that God wants to lay to rest. I have seen this too many times & don't want to be guilty of it! I have prayed much since receiving the news of Immanuel no longer being able to host the event to see if our Father would want to resurrect it somewhere else-on a much smaller scale, of course-but maybe He doesn't. No matter how much Via & the love of it runs in my blood, it would not be best to try to perpetuate it if it is not our Father's pleasure. That is our ultimate goal & end! In the meantime, Kim & I are scrambling & strategizing re: what to do with all of the stuff-& where to put it!

## "FROM THE COUCH TO THE FLOOR-IN SECONDS"



Pastor Peter Miller of *Friends of the Cross Church* in Corning, N.Y. was my best man in our wedding. Peter & I met & became very close at *Elim Bible Institute*. From 2011-2018 he gave me the huge honor & blessing of being the guest minister at a community day camp his church hosted called *Camp Victory*. It saw very rapid growth over those 8 years & it was another delight of my life to not only be involved its inaugural year but for 7 more years after that! For any of you who have not had such a medical procedure, you lay on a plastic table that rolls you into a tube completely surrounding your body. You only have a few inches between your face & the top of the tube. For anyone who suffers from claustrophobia, this is not the medical procedure for you! For patients who do suffer from this malady, they administer what is called "conscious sedation". The secret for those who choose not to go the sedative route for the 20+ minutes you're in the tube is to keep your eyes closed. Before inserting you into the tube, the technician offers you headphones with music. I always decline the music as I know it will pump into my head the din/revelry/party spirit of the world. As I was waiting for the scan to begin, I asked the Lord, "Lord, what text shall I think about during this?". I chose Isaiah 42:1. "Behold, My Servant, Whom, I uphold, My Chosen One, in Whom My soul delights." This is the prophet Isaiah speaking under the inspiration & unction of the Holy Spirit.
