"VIA DOLOROSA #14-2017 NOW HIS-STORY"

Dear Friends & Family, "The 2nd Battle of 'Wounded Knee'?"



[4/12] Last evening was opening night for the public for our church's 14th annual **VIA DOLOROSA** production. As always, we encountered the various & sundry glitches, hassles, deterrents, etc. with personnel, equipment, staging, timing, etc., but, again, as always, our very faithful God ensured that the saving story of His precious Son was dramatized & proclaimed. This year was particularly hard for me personally. I was dealing with a very sore knee & foot throughout the production. This was a considerable distraction. Each evening before I headed to church I'd smear analgesic cream on it & tightly wrap it with a neoprene knee brace. At times the bottom of my foot would hurt too. I'm suspecting this is residual pain from my bout with GBS last October. GBS can remain in the body for 6 months to a year after you contract it. Unfortunately, for me, who needs to "feel" his part, re: emoting & pace, it was a huge detriment. In addition, due to some unknowing rookie cast members early in the week, the pace of the groups walking through the building was the fastest in 14 years. They were releasing groups to move on to the next station prematurely. This hugely affected me, again, re: not "feeling" the part. Those of you who know me know I'm emotionally wired. [Sigh-poor Kim.]. I was cutting out lines in my Dungeon episode so as to be on time in my Fort episode [I'm the only cast member of the 100 or so who does two different episodes. This happened out of necessity years ago as the Dungeon scene was too excruciating the way it was set up. Hence, I inserted a drama in there.] In addition to these encumbrances this year, I was still grieving the loss of my Dad in March. I

say all of that to say this: the testimonies that follow I'm sure "feed my vanity & flesh", but I post them to show how, despite the various & sundry weaknesses & struggles this servant of the Lord was going through, our God was still faithful to help, touch, & use me to minister to His people, & to those who didn't know Him:

I will close, Beloved, with these thoughts-despite the above "praise", you'll never know how many episodes of Via [I did 87 altogether] this Roman Procurator was repenting in my heart while in the middle of my dramas. I love to act-I was deeply affected as a 16 year-old in a movie theater watching "The 10 Commandments"but I'm called to preach. Via is such an outlet for my creative & theatrical bugs that are deeply embedded in me. However, it also makes me more vulnerable to vanity, pride, fleshly desires, praise-of-men-coveting, etc., that I have to constantly guard & cleanse my heart. I know one day, on that Great Day, that every episode will be watched & reviewed by our Lord Jesus, before all who saw them. The thoughts of my heart during each episode will be exposed on that Day too-not for judgment, but for bequeathing or losing of reward. I know for many of the thousands of episodes I've done since 2004 in Via I will lose rewards for service I could've obtained. These sobering thoughts fuel a divine fire in me to strive for purity of heart as I "perform" for men-desiring to have in my heart The Godhead as my Sole Audience. If He graces me to do Via in the years ahead, & I hope so very much He does, I pray He will enable me to do so. Yours, "Pilate".
