Several months ago she was asked to be the Children's Ministry Director of a ministry affiliated with The Assemblies of God, a.k.a., "LEAD THE GENERATION". This ministry has existed for quite some time but up until recently only offered ministry & resources to youth workers. The head of the ministry realized there was also a dire need for equipping children's workers as well. Jess has been involved with children's ministry for many years & has much experience in that field. LEAD THE GENERATION was having a conference in Pittsburgh, PA this past August. Jess asked me months ago if I could attend & speak at some of its breakout sessions. Unfortunately, the conference happened to be scheduled during the same week as my *Hopewell Summer Camps* Kids Camp. In the light of that

"CABOOSE! MEETS 'FEET ON THE STREET"



The Caboose! recently returned to "the land of its birth", vis, Reading, PA to minister for the first time at a ministry called "Feet On The Street", founded by Daryl & Rebecca Zimmerman. This ultra-crucial outreach to the young in the city of Reading was started 20+ years ago. It is nestled in a little building that has been remodeled. It used to be a restaurant, & prior to that a battery warehouse. Now, it is used to "feed" & "recharge" people in a whole new way-an eternal way! Despite having lived in the Reading area for 5 years prior to moving to DE, & despite having done much inner-city ministry with my Caboose! team while we lived there, I had rarely if ever been to this part of town on the west side. As soon as I pulled up in my truck to unload I realized it was "prime real estate" as far as ministry to the young goes. There were several youth & children both at FOTS playing basketball, as well as a plethora of them across the street at a city park! I heard kids screaming when I got out of the truck as in the park there was a fountain. I assumed the kids were getting jolted by the cold water as they ran through it

I proceeded to unload my ministry equipment as quickly as I could. For the first time that I could remem-ber in 22+ years of itinerant ministry, my plan was to give this group "4 parts" of ministry that evening. I had asked Rebecca weeks before if their group would be ok with not having worship in song that night, as in order to accomplish these 4 ministry phases I needed all of the time they could afford. I told them I prayed they would see what I do is "worship" too. They cordially consented. Rebecca said it would also be a nice break for the worship team. After having setup my numerous & various object lessons for "The Pro-cess of Illumination", i.e., how the Holy Spirit gives us understanding into the inspired texts of the Bible & what happens when He does, as well as my Bible Quiz machine, I sat down in a chair & prayerfully waited for the meeting to begin. Daryl Zimmerman, my host, introduced me, but beforehand he recounted memories of "Caboose!" he had as a child & also of his time at Hopewell Summer Camp as well. He even remembered me rearing up on a horse at camp for one of my hsc Director's "equestrian field dramas"! For "Part 1", I asked all of the leaders in the room to rise & lay hands on the heads or shoulders of the children & youth & ask Jesus to bless them as they did so. At the same time, I asked the "Feet on the 'Streeters'" in attendance to ask Jesus to touch them as their leaders did. I base this ministry practice on what Jesus did with the young when they were brought to Him. For "Part 2", I commenced with my "Process of Illumination" message, to provide reasons why for Part 3 we would read, reread, & highlight our Bibles. As just mentioned, "Part 3" entailed taking Matthew 4:1-4 & reading it 8X or so, & marking it with a different color each time as we looked for different elements in the passage, vis, "Who, When, Where", etc. The ultimate hope by studying this way is that the Holy Spirit, by "giving Him time" to do so, would illuminate the text with understanding of what He inspired the Sacred authors of the Bible to write so many centuries ago. "Part 4" entailed quizzing the attendants, & by the way, they were comprised of all ages, from young children to senior citizens, re: what we just studied & highlighted. I have been in full-time ministry since 1986, but I never recall once in all of those years speaking/ministering in one setting for as long as I did at Feet On The Street! I began around 7:45 p.m. & I think I finished around 10 p.m.! This included prayer, teaching, preaching, expounding on the texts we were highlighting, & then quizzing the group at the end. When I counseled this boy that year I myself was *40 years old!* There is both blessing & sobriety when you stay at the same ministry for such a long span of years. You are truly impacted that life is but a vapor. This is a strong scriptural motivation to live for The One Who died for you. May it always be so. Sincerely, Michael
