"ELECTED HEADS" OF (the 'eternal') STATE @ 'SIGHT AND SOUND'"



[9/12] Late last month, Kim & I attended Sight & Sound Theatre's annual "INSIPRE" event. Pastors & leaders of ministries are invited to come for the afternoon to participate in worship, communion, an interview with the producer of the particular dramatic production to be performed that day, the actual performance (this year it was "Moses"), & a meal following. All of this is provided free-of-charge by Sight & Sound. As Kim & I sat through the performance, a number of times the special effects of the production required that bright white spotlights flash intermittently upon the audience. As I sat there, my focus turned from the show to the audience. My heart sank inside from brokenness & grateful awe. I felt tears starting to come. "How so, Michael?" I feel as if the Lord gave me a small glimpse of how He saw His people. All I saw was the back of human heads. But as I watched, what I realized & was reminded of struck deeply inside my soul. Every one of these precious people were, ultimately, sitting there for one reason, & one reason only. God, for His Own unknown but holy & wise purposes & goodpleasure, chose them in eternity past, before the foundation of the world (Eph.1:4), to be His own. He chose, way back then, to predestine every one of them, to be adopted as His sons (children), to Himself (Eph.1:5). Of the massive lump of fallen humanity (Rom.9:21), these were some whom He chose to be His vessels of mercy-whom He prepared beforehand for glory (Rom.9:23). These were some of those whom the Father, at some point in eternity past, gave to His Son Jesus Christ (Jn.6:37, 44, 65 10:29, 17:2,6,9,24; Heb.2:13; Acts 13:48).

Moments later, this tender compassion that I was feeling for God's was followed by an acute sadness. Why? I would dare say that many of them have never heard, or at the very least, have never understood these precious, God-glorifying, soul-melting truths, which are spread throughout the entirety of God's Word. How very sad, how very tragic it is, that so many of the Lord's sheep will never realize the precious truth, "You have not chosen Me, but I have chosen you" (Jn.15:16), until they are in glory with their "Chooser". As I've written before, once a Christian realizes this, they are never the same. And, NO Christian understands this until well after their conversion. I've often likened it to the scene in *The Wizard of Oz* (1939) re: Dorothy Gale of Kansas, upon her arrival in Munchkin Land. It is only then, that her life goes from black & white to color! That is a very good analogy to describe what happens to a Christian when they realize that ultimately, the sole reason they are in Heaven, is-*pure mercy*.

Every one of those who received it had their hearts warmed by the memory.



<u>"VITAMIN 'B-3' PRESCRIPTION FOR POST-CAMP SEASON HEALTH"</u>

[9/11] Oftentimes, on Friday morning of camp, before the campers give their testimonies re: what God did in their lives during the week, I prescribe for them **vitamin B3** to take on a regular basis until camp next year. "B3"? Yes. The first B is the "**Book**", vis, **the Bible**. Man shall not live by food only, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God [Mt.4:4]. The second B is the "**Bird**", vis, the **Holy Spirit**. He is our daily sustaining power. He produces the life & health of God in us. By Him, we put to death sin on a daily basis, worship & intercede, & are conformed into the image of Jesus. The third B is the "**Body**", i.e., The **Body of Christ**. I tell the campers that

Jesus has so ordained it that we need His Body, His people, in order to make it in this life. He has knit us together by His Spirit. If an arm is severed from the body, it dies. I tell the campers Jesus "wants" them depressed, full of sorrow & troubles, etc., if they avoid fellowship with His people. If He *blessed them* while they avoided His people, they'd probably never come back! It's His faithfulness that He has ordained it so. Hence, regular attendance in youth group & church is a must in order to their soul's health. Take your **B3**!



"MY 3 'CONES' THAT SAFEGUARD MY LIFE & MINISTRY"

Speaking of spiritual health & guidance, I told the campers at Sr. Hi. Camp this past summer about the "**3 Cones**" I have had in my life for many, many years that keep me "on course" on a daily basis-3 guide-posts, 3 guardrails, if you will. The **1**st **cone** is that <u>the whole world is going</u> <u>to Hell</u>. Jesus said in Mat. 7:13,14 that wide is the gate & broad is the road that leads to destruction, & many are those who find it. If He had stopped there, there could be (& sadly are!) those who could argue, "Yes, Jesus did say many would end in the eternal destruction of their souls in Hell, but there will be more souls in Heaven than those who wind up in the Lake of Fire. But, Jesus *didn't* stop there. He then said, "Narrow is the gate, & constricted is the path that leads to life, & *few* are those who find it." He couldn't have been more clear in His soulstirring & sobering words. [Note: I'm very well aware that the multitude of the redeemed in Heaven for all eternity will be a number that no one can count (Rev. 7:9)]. However, based on our Lord Jesus' words above, compared to the entire population of the human race from Adam until the last human being is conceived, the total number is "few". The **2nd cone** that daily regulates my life is "Judgment Day is coming". "God has appointed a day in which He will judge the world in righteousness, through a Man Whom He has appointed, having furnished proof to all men by raising Him from the dead" [Acts 17:31]. "...God will bring every deed into judgment, whether good or evil, & every secret thing [Ecc.12:11]. Nothing is hidden that will not be revealed [Lk.8:17]. Every minute of every day of my life, I will give an account for, when I stand before the Lord Jesus on His glorious throne. He will ask for an explanation for each day re: what I did with my time, health, energy, resources, gifts & talents that He gave me, etc. And, our Lord also said, "To whom much is given-much is required" [Lk. 12:48]. Countless Christians, including myself, on That Great Day, will wish then they had yielded & surrendered more fully to the Lord's Word, Spirit, & guidance during their very short tenure on planet Earth. The 3rd cone is that the gospel must be preached. There is only one God, Who only has one Son, Who died once & for all, for all who would believe in Him. All who don't believe in & obey Him will certainly perish eternally, having offended an eternal God. There is only one message that relates this indescribable truth of Divine rescueathe gospel. The Devil hates it, & attempts to block, hinder, & thwart it at all costs. He does so by diluting & polluting its message via a vast array & plethora of false teachers. In addition, the evil one, the hater of men's souls, also constantly & relentlessly attacks faithful bearers of this glorious message of how to escape from the wrath to come. These 3 cones constantly help me keep focused, on task, & greatly help me keep my hand to the plow-not looking back.

[9/25] If I added a 4th cone to the above 3, it definitely would be the "I **Cor. 2:2 Cone**", namely, "<u>I am deter-mined to know nothing when I am with you, but Jesus Christ-& Him crucified</u>." This is my compass, my daystar, my guiding light to my doctrine, life, & ministry. This Christ-centered thrust is my own personal "tip-of-the-spear". I wish it was everyone's, particularly ministers. Tragically, it is not. It is not. If it were, the unending glut of false, aberrant, tangential, peripheral, mystically-based, etc., doctrines would not exist. And, oh, what a glorious thing that would be! This precious Scripture verse, when deeply embedded in one's soul, keeps them from the limitless "doctrinal fads", &, may I say, "Christian causes", that come down the Church pike at a seemingly increasingly rapid pace these days. 

[9/30] Ever since I lived with my maternal grandparents in Missouri during the summer of 1974, just a few months after the Lord apprehended me in a convent there, I've wanted a **Chevy** pickup truck. Why? ""Pop" bought a brand new 1973 white Chevy truck while I was there & I immediately fell in love with it. Pop would *reluctantly* let me drive it to town on rare occasions, & I don't blame him! Well, after several decades I bought my "dream truck" from a friend nearby here in DE in November 2021. Upon doing so, I offered my previous ministry vehicle, vis, a **2000 Nissan Frontier**, which I had owned for 15 years, to my home away from home, **Tel Hai Camp**. When I did so, I assumed they'd make it a camp vehicle for around the campgrounds. I was surprisingly amazed when I learned they soon made it "road-worthy" in the state of Pennsylvania! The Frontier served me well for those 15 years in my itinerant ministry, & it would probably take another whole newsletter to share all of my adventures in "new frontiers" in the Lord's work. Well, let's go back 21 years. I was preaching at an Elim-connected church in the Princeton, N.J. area, & after the service, my host took me past the once famous theological bulwark of the Christian faith-**Princeton Seminary**. It long ago went liberal, which prompted **J**.

Gresham Machen to move on from it in the early 20th century to form today's present Westminster Seminary in Philadelphia. During Princeton's glory years, a master theologian named Charles Hodge taught there for 56 years. When I embarked in the ministry in 1986, at my church back then, I was given a book budget. I saw Hodge's 3 volume "magnus opus" of theology on sale. I knew nothing of him, but when I saw the offer, I remember thinking to myself, "Huh-he taught at Princeton for 56 years-he must know something." And, I bought the set. I had no idea of the gold mine I had purchased. My jaw was on the floor, so to speak, several times as I gorged upon Hodge's insights into grace & sovereignty. I have never been the same. The Lord used Hodge to "deliver me" from many unscriptural notions I held, &, along with them, many fears. Well, when we drove past the building at Princeton where Hodge's office was on the top floor, my host told me it's been said that when people go into his office, a powerful presence can still be felt in the room. Wow. I was in awe. Elim Bible Institute, my alma mater, has had the same reputation for many decades too. Elim is famous for missions, & worship. Countless alumni & visitors over the years have said you can feel the Lord's presence when you walk onto the campus. I would concur with that experience-several times. Back to my Frontier. **Dean Weiler**, a dear brother in the Lord, sent me a text yesterday with a picture of my former truck in his shop. He was doing work on it. This is what he told me after sending the picture: "...working on this today...very cool... many unique Guertin upgrades!...you can still feel the Spirit when you get into it. Goosebumps!" [Dean Weiler, Tel Hai Camp board member] Beloved, I don't even know what to say to this. My first reaction was that Dean, being the kind, sweet, & humble brother that he is, was just trying to encourage me. Believe me, I'll take every drop of encouragement I can get! I have my doubts re: his precious comment, but, if our Lord touched him while working on it, I am forever grateful & humbled. Wow. Jesus!
