<u>"A HEART WITH FAT AROUND IT"</u>



I have written before about the sad & tragic debacle I have witnessed for 50 years now among God's people, including myself. It is a spiritual malady, an often unseen & undetected heart condition that often slowly creeps up upon God's people, especially those engaged in areas of regular, routine service in Christian institutions. They may & often do include church staffs, worship teams, Christian schools, seminaries, & Bible schools. There is something about the nature of the human heart, that when it is around "the holy things" & in a Christian environment on a regular basis, that a sinister familiarity creeps up upon it. It is a very grievous thing to me, & also a terrifying one. In this case the old adage, "Familiarity breeds contempt" most certainly applies. Two prime examples from the Scriptures both involved relatively young people-Nadab & Abihu (Lev. 10:1,2), & Hophni & Phineas (I Sam. 2:12ff). All 4 of them were sons of a minister, & a very prominent & prestigious minister at that! They grew up in church. They basically lived in church. They both heard & saw the Word of God & the sacred things on a daily basis. Yet, these divine elements became routine, familiar, might I even say, "boring"? The fear of God had definitely "lifted" from these young men a long time prior to their premature deaths, via execution by the Lord of Hosts Himself. "Now the young men would not listen to their father's rebuke, because it was the will of the Lord to put them to death" (I Sam.2:25). Had these young men known what disastrous fate awaited them, they surely would have striven to keep a healthy & constant fear, honor, & reverence of the Lord. This they did not do. When it comes to the point that God Himself, either directly via fire from Heaven as in the case of Nadab & Abihu, or via secondary causes, vis, the Philistines, puts people to death, you can be sure it was a long time coming. How so? Because of Who He is. "The Lord, the Lord God, compassionate & gracious, slow to anger, & abounding in lovingkindness & truth..." (Ex. 34:6). Their blatant irreverent & disregard for the honor of the Lord surely was a slow process-a gradual, yet constant one. This is the spiritual fat that sinisterly slithers its way around the human heart. If it is not detected & slain, it can prove deadly. Symptoms of it are flippancy,

glibness, indifference, lack of response to God's Word (God holds in high esteem those who tremble at it. Isa.66:2), excessive levity, a lack of soberness when in the presence of God, etc. Very often, this is easily noticeable in large churches. Huge crowds (which can easily & often result in "crowd dynamics", which are regularly assumed to be visitations of God), lots of excitement, lots of money, lots of activity, lots of programs, etc. It is easy to equate "bigness" as a sign of God's favor & blessing. I have seen countless churches & ministries get "smug", arrogant, & falsely secure, assuming God has brought this expansion in size. Sadly, & way too often, it was not the Lord Who increased their numbers, but their "marketing" strategies, their catering & pandering to the lost (when biblically, church gatherings are primarily for the saints), their succumbing to worldly tactics & amusements to "bring people in". A pastor friend told me years ago re: this way too common tragic phenomenon in so many American churches, "It is hard to examine oneself in the arena of 'success'". How very, very true this is. Hence, I felt to begin my message to the FCA students that morning with the above warning, but in a much more highly condensed way. I followed this with my "Process of Illumination" message, which challenges God's people to seek the illumination/understanding of the Scriptures via the Holy Spirit Who originally inspired the authors of the Sacred Text. Once He opens up the Scriptures to us, as the Lord Jesus did for the 2 disciples on the Emmaus Road after His resurrection, our hearts "burn within us" (Lk. 24:32). This "process" is what ensures that that sinister spiritual fat mentioned above does not wrap itself around our hearts, which, by the way, it is always striving to do! May He help us.


<u>"STARING AT THE FLAME"</u>



When we arrived in OH on the 2nd leg of our Triangle Trip, we had some very historical family meetings with our oldest son Matthew, his wife Devon, & their 5 children. The gatherings had to do with their major decision to switch Christian schools for 4 of their 5 kids. So, a couple of times while we were there, Matthew would call the family to gather on the backyard patio, which had a circle of lawn chairs around a stainless steel fire pit. After Scripture reading, being given response handouts for all of us to read & fill out later, prayer, & much discussion, the kids would one by one file out & go their separate ways. Matthew, Devon, Kim, & I remained & chatted some more. After some time elapsed, my mind wandered from the conversation & just stared at the flames of fire in the fire pit in front of me. I began to ponder & meditate on the sohard-to-believe & conceive reality of Hell, Gehenna, The Lake of Fire. I thought to myself how excruciatingly painful it would be just to insert my hand into this flame for a few seconds. My mind & heart could not take in the following thought that there will be an unfathomable score of human souls who will spend eternity in this "eternal nightmare". Dante in his "Divine Comedy" said of Hell, "Abandon hope, all you who enter here." I can barely type these thoughts now. My heart & soul are sinking as I do so. This, Beloved, is the fear of the Lord. It is pure. It is clean. It is sobering. It doesn't drive you away from God, but toward Him! THIS is one of the means He uses to keep that "heart fat" from engulfing your heart. And, if it is already present, to remove it. But my meditation didn't end there. I thought to myself, "O God, O God, how very, very holy You must be, that You must burn forever those who hate You, who hate all things righteous, who love & embrace sin & wickedness. We don't 'get' You, Lord. We just don't

'get' You." Actually, when you stumble at the reality & severity & eternality of Hell, you must rush to thoughts of the immensity, infinitude, blazing & blinding holiness, & depths of the love of God-even the death of His Son in place of sinners. Jesus was beaten, wounded, bruised, scourged, pierced, slapped, spat upon, despised, & rejected by men. Remember, Beloved, this was GOD they were doing this to! Yes-given the infinite magnificence of His Person & dignity, if it weren't created by the Lord Jesus Himself, I would say Hell isn't hot enough, or long enough, for those who hate Him. And yes, but for His great grace, there go I.
